History of July 18

- ◆ **1290** : King Edward of England ordered the expulsion of the Jews.
- ◆ **1857** : Bombay University was established.
- ◆ **1951** : Uruguay adopted the constitution.
- ◆ **1947** : The Indian Parliament was forced to pass the law of independence of this country.
- ◆ **1980** : Completely India-made satellite Rohini-1 was established in the Earth's orbit.

Current Affairs Related to 18 July

- ◆ Global public debt will soar to a record \$92 trillion in 2022, a UN report said, as governments borrow to deal with crises such as the COVID-19 pandemic. Its burden is felt more severely on developing countries. According to a report released for the G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors meeting on July 14, 18, the world's domestic and external debt has increased fivefold in the past two decades, which is the rate of economic growth, GDP has only tripled since 2002. It is done.
- ◆ The National Real Estate Development Council has announced the setting up of its Delhi Chapter. Harshvardhan Bansal, Director, Unity Group, has been appointed as the President of NAREDCO Delhi Chapter. The National Real Estate Development Council is a leading national organization representing the real estate sector, working under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.
- ◆ The Jammu and Kashmir Rural Livelihoods Mission has been awarded the SKOCH Award in the Gold category under the theme State of Governance India 2047. JKRLM has been awarded for its efforts in providing marketing opportunities to Self Help Groups in the Union Territory.
- ◆ The Union Cabinet has approved changes in the Jan Vishwas Bill 2023. The Bill seeks to decriminalize petty offenses by amending 183 provisions in 42 Acts. It proposes to amend 183 provisions in 42 Acts administered by 19 ministries. Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal introduced the Jan Vishwas Bill in the Lok Sabha on 22 December 2023.
- ◆ Vinod Mankara's book was released from the rocket launchpad of Satish Dhawan Space Centre. The title of the book is Prism: The Ancestral Abode of Rainbow. This is a collection of science articles. It is a compilation of 50 articles on space science, astronomy, biology, anthropology and mathematics.
- ◆ Scindia inaugurated the Eastern Cross Taxiways and the fourth runway at the Delhi airport. With ECT, this airport will be the only airport in India to have an elevated taxiway with roads passing beneath it.
- ◆ As per the Ministry of Textiles, 43 new implementation partners have been empaneled under the SMARTH scheme with an additional training target of 75,000 beneficiaries and a 5% increase in the support of implementation partners. Empowered Committee for Capacity Building Scheme in Textile Sector announced induction of 43 new implementation partners with additional training of 75,000 beneficiaries.
- ◆ In the meeting of the Defense Acquisition Council chaired by Defense Minister Shri Rajnath Singh, three important proposals were approved with the aim of increasing India's naval capabilities. Under the first proposal, the Defense Acquisition Council approved the requirement for the purchase of 26 Rafale seaplanes from the French government.
- ◆ INS Sunayana participated in Operation Southern Readiness 2023. Operation Southern Readiness 2023 is a multinational initiative. It aims to enhance maritime security, combat piracy to ensure security and freedom of navigation in the region.
- ◆ Microsoft researchers announced a significant breakthrough in the creation of Majorana zero modes, a type of particle that has potential implications for revolutionizing quantum computing. Microsoft researchers created a topological superconductor from an aluminum superconductor and indium arsenide semiconductor.
- ◆ The Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority provides an effective system for the protection of plant varieties, the rights of farmers and plant breeders, and the encouragement of the development of new plant varieties.

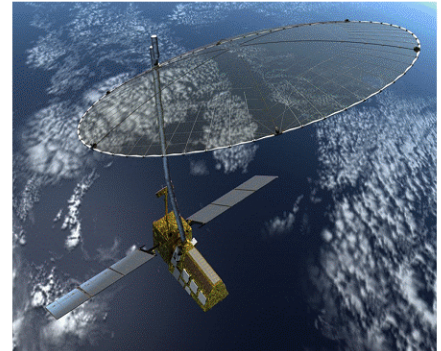

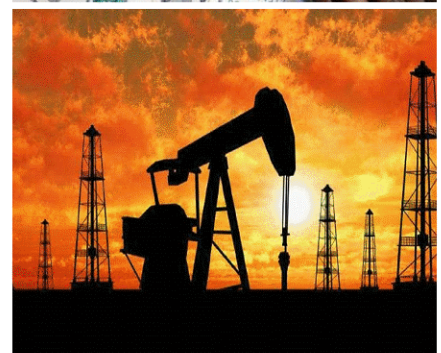

The increase in foreign exchange reserves was mainly driven by an increase in foreign currency assets and gold reserves, while a marginal decline was seen in special drawing rights.
