- Bollywood actor Kartik Aaryan will be honored with the Rising Global Superstar of Indian Cinema award at the annual awards ceremony of the 14th Indian Film Festival of Melbourne on August 11. The award, presented by the Governor of Victoria, recognizes Karthik's remarkable achievements and his significant impact on the world of Indian cinema. The festival celebrates the diversity and richness of Indian cinema, showcasing the talent and creativity of Indian filmmakers to a global audience.
- American company Meta said it is expanding business initiatives with WhatsApp. The giant tech company will digitize 1 crore public traders in association with the Confederation of All India Traders. The instant messaging platform owned by the Confederation of All India Traders and global tech company Meta will work under the partnership. Together they will digitally train and skill 1 crore local traders in the country.
- Kerala Governor Arif Mohammed Khan released the Malayalam translation of Krishna The 7th Sense by IIM-Kozhikode Director Debasish Chatterjee. He also unveiled the latest edition of Shri Chatterjee's Kriti Karma Sutra Leadership and Wisdom in Uncertain Times, the flagship book in the IIM Penguin series for budding managers.
- The application process for the second phase of Ladli Bahna Yojana, an ambitious initiative of the state government, has started. The scheme, launched this year, aims to empower women financially. Eligible women can now apply from five different places, and this time the eligibility criteria have been relaxed to give benefits to more women and daughters. This Madhya Pradesh government scheme ensures that eligible members receive a monthly transfer of Rs 1000 in their bank accounts on the 10th of every month, further enhancing their financial stability and independence.

- Power Finance Corporation Limited has achieved a milestone by becoming the first Indian participant in the Asia Transition Finance Study Group, an initiative of the Japanese Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry to promote sustainable transition finance in Asian countries. By being part of this initiative, PFC will not only contribute to India's perspective but will also assist in formulating policy ideas to facilitate efficient energy transition financing.
- Union Home Minister Amit Shah laid the foundation stone of 108 feet tall statue of Lord Shri Ram in Kurnool. A grand statue of Lord Shri Ram will be built at Mantralaya village in Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh at a cost of over Rs 500 crore. The 108 feet tall statue of Lord Shri Ram in Mantralayam will give the message of Sanatana Dharma to the whole world. This will also help in strengthening the Vaishnava tradition in the country and the world.
- Gujarat's first greenfield airport was inaugurated by PM Modi at Hirasar near Rajkot. This airport, built in an area of 1500 acres at a cost of 1405 crores, has been renamed as Rajkot International Airport. The greenfield airport at Hirasar is 30 km from Rajkot city, the commercial capital of the Saurashtra region.
- American social media platform Twitter has launched a new logo. It has removed Blue Bird from its website. Twitter's site has revealed its new logo, a white X on a black background. The new ones were unveiled by Twitter owner Elon Musk and its CEO Linda Yacarino.
- Scientists have made surprising revelations about the world's largest permafrost crater in Russia's Far East in a video obtained from drone footage. This crater is the Batagaika crater. According to him, this permafrost is melting due to the warming of the earth, due to which the concerns of scientists have increased.


